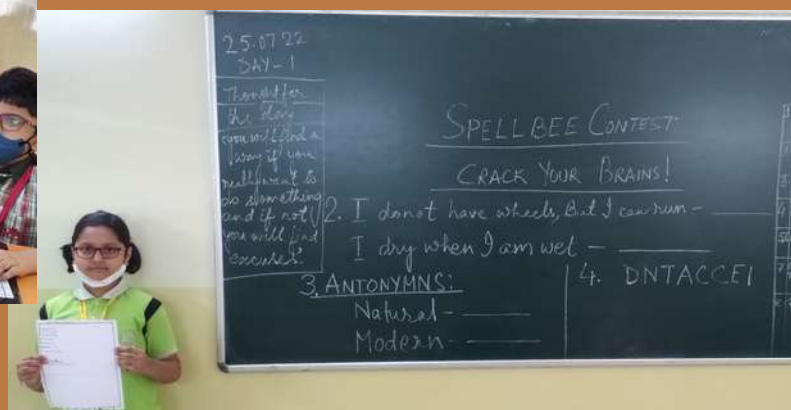


Van Mahotsav Week

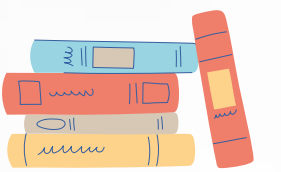


Social Science Exhibition

Hindi Diwas Celebration



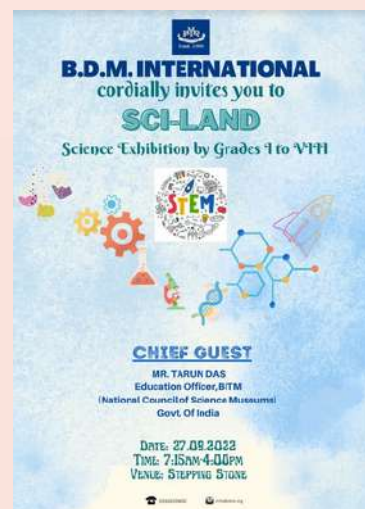
Students of B.D.M.I took the opportunity to honour the Hindi language by different cultural activities like song & recitation.

World Gratitude Day

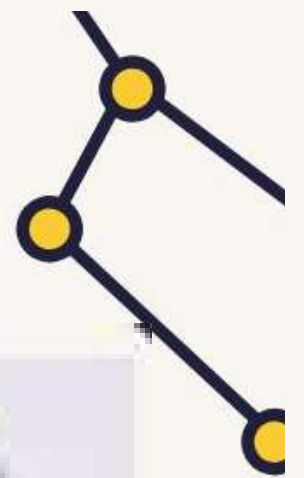


B.D.M.I celebrated World Gratitude Day by showing respect to their grandparents and the frontline workers. The Interact club met the frontline workers and showed their respect to them.

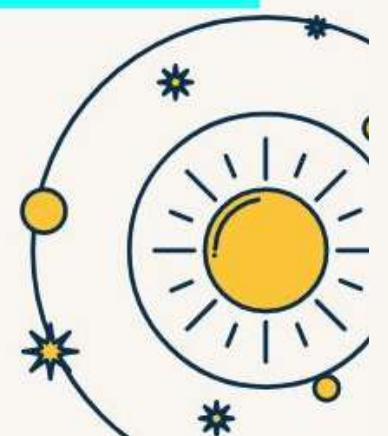
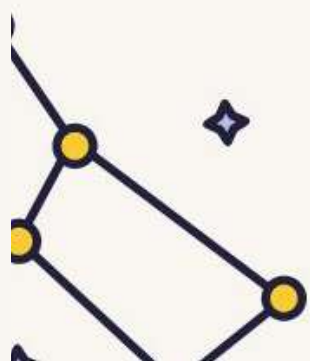
INTERACT CLUB ACTIVITIES

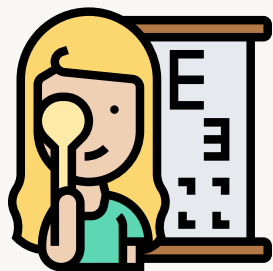
Special Career Counselling Session on Biology

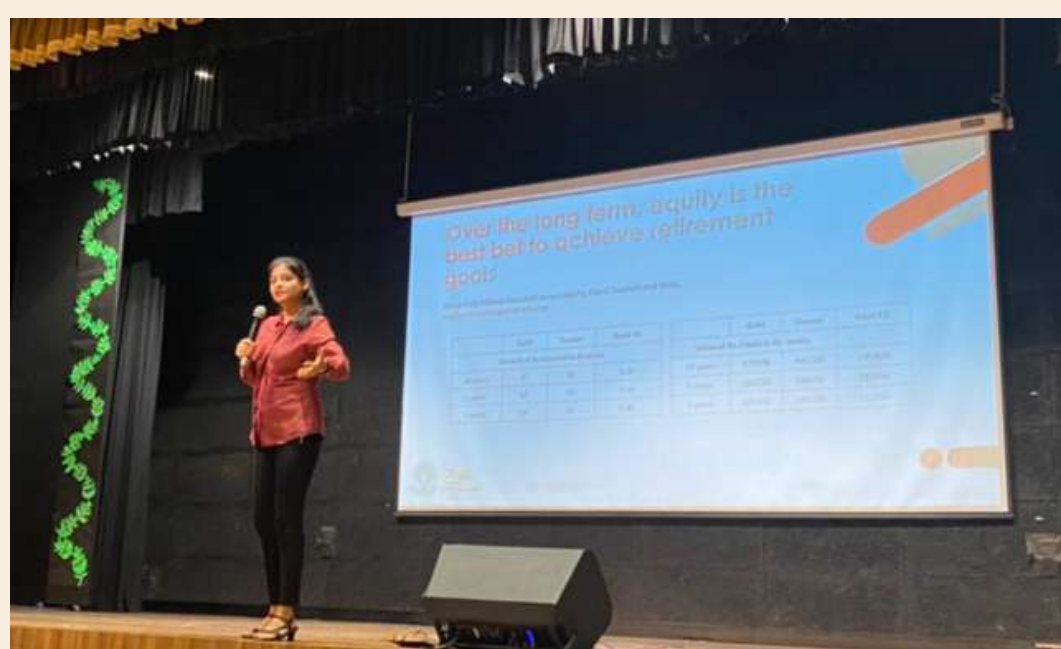
Inter School Patriotic Meet 2022

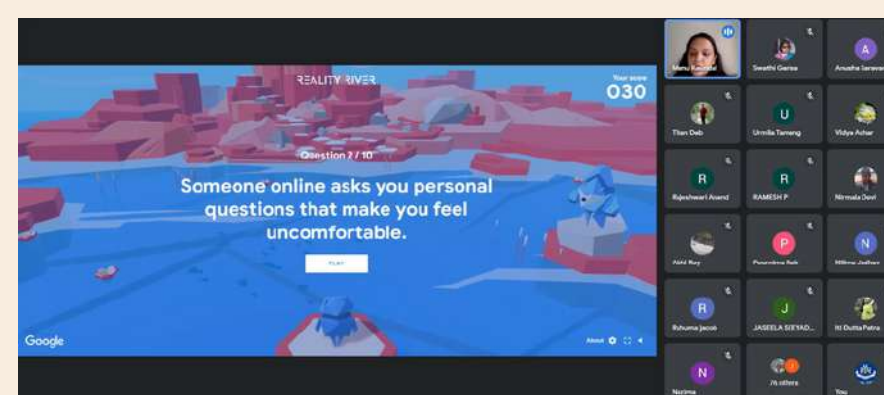
Financial Literacy Workshop

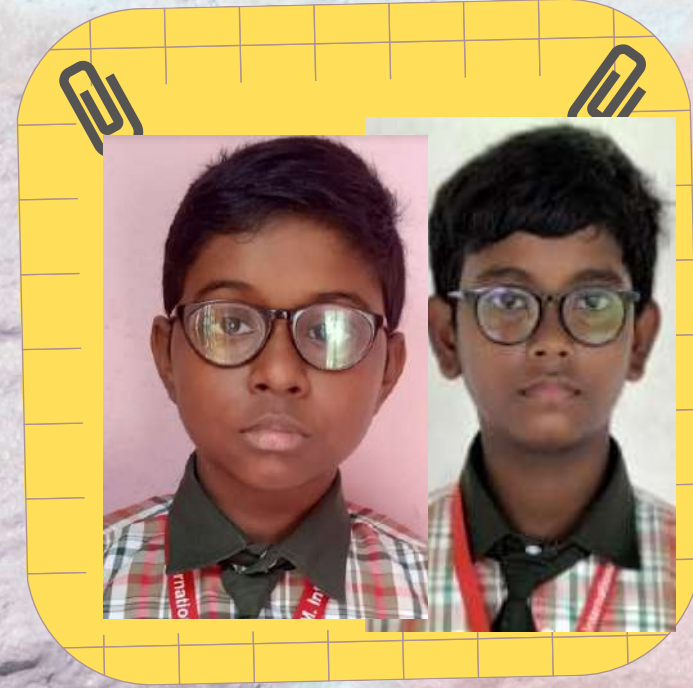

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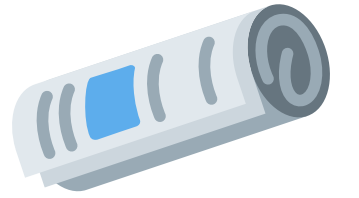
