

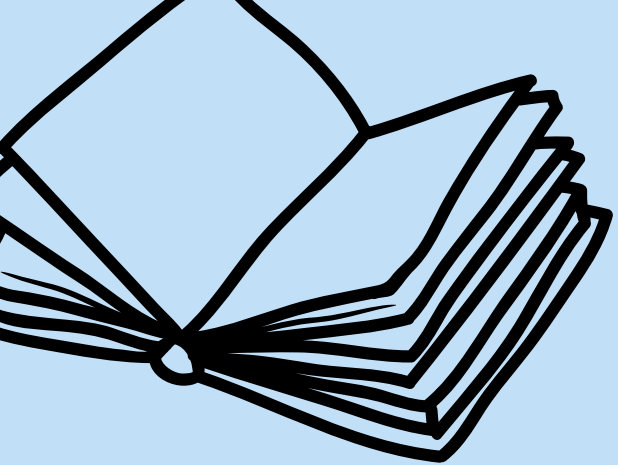

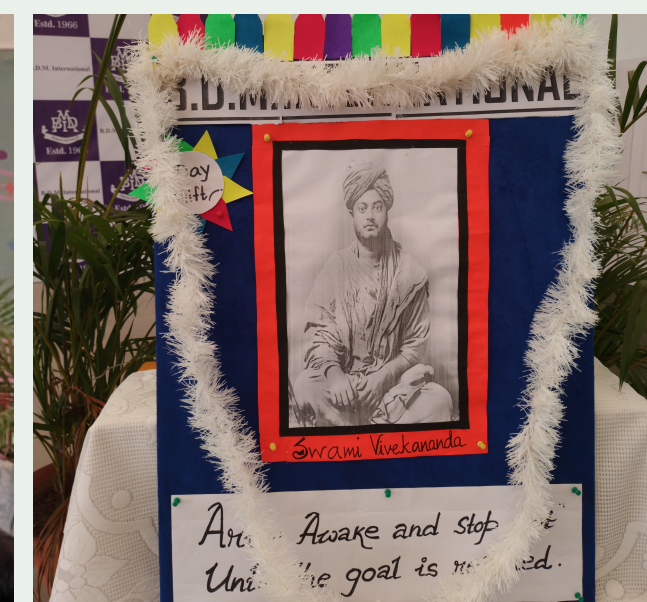
National Road safety Day Week

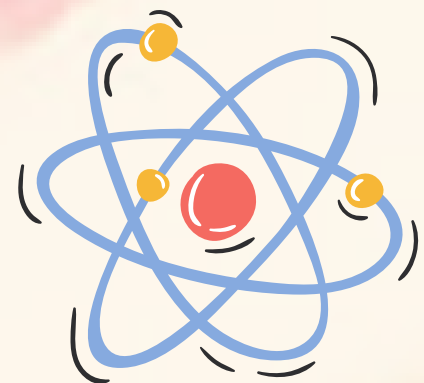


Mock Parliament session

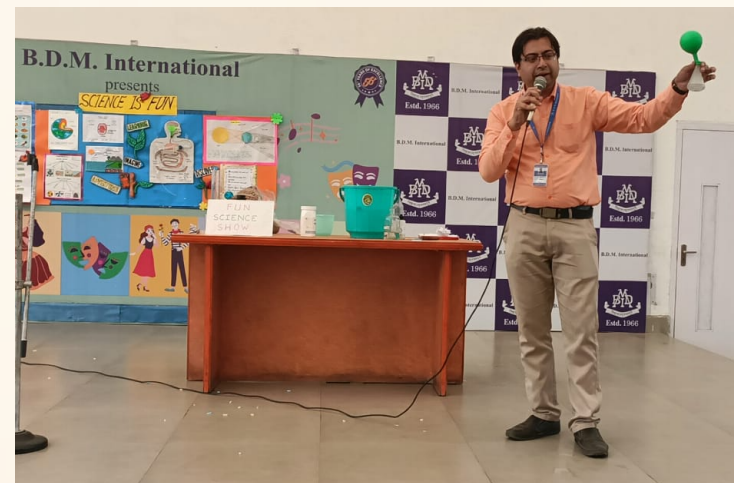


Saraswati Puja & Republic Day craft activity

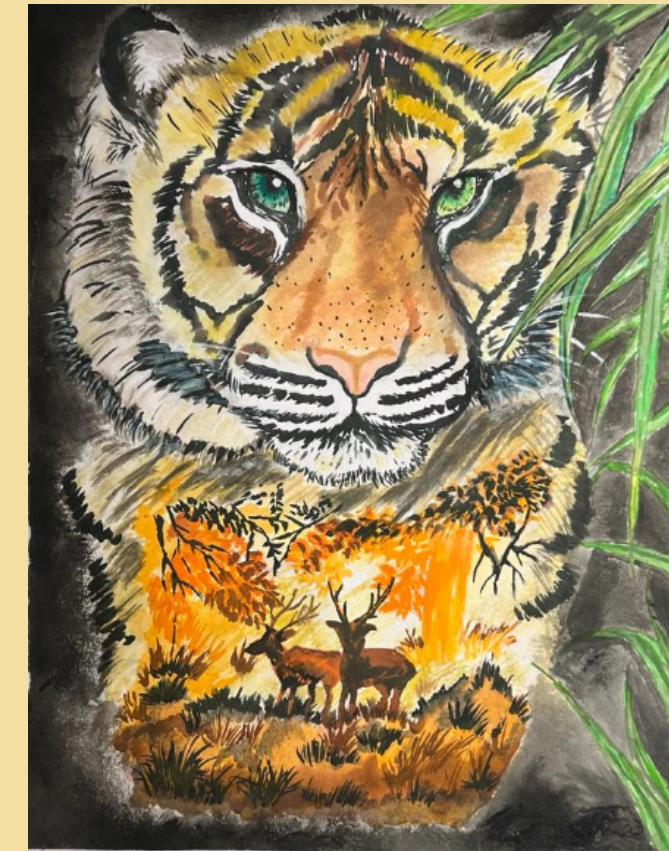
PTM & BOOK FAIR

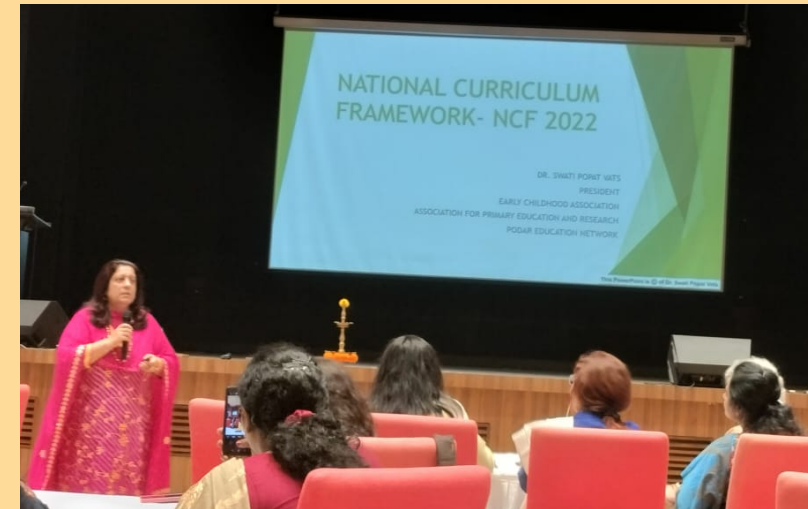


Ship Building

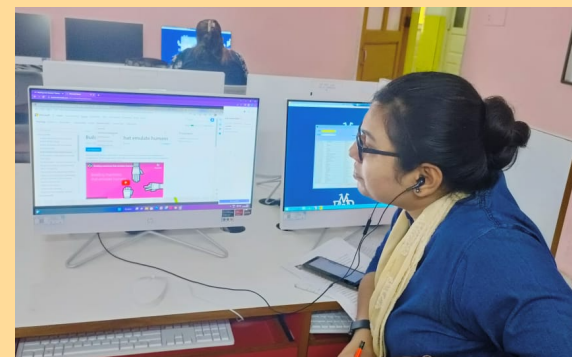

A workshop was arranged for the teachers



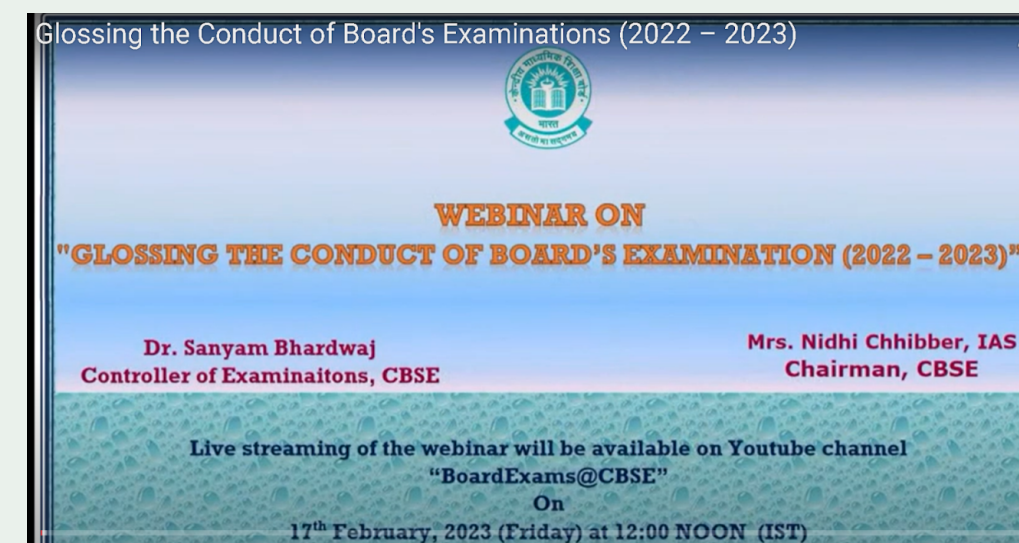
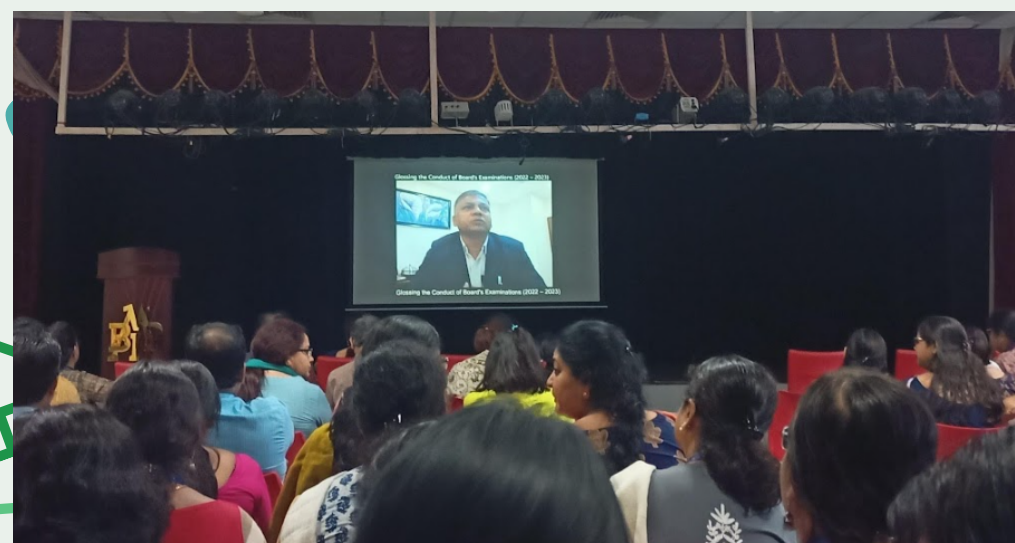
Edumorphosis Teachers' Training Workshop

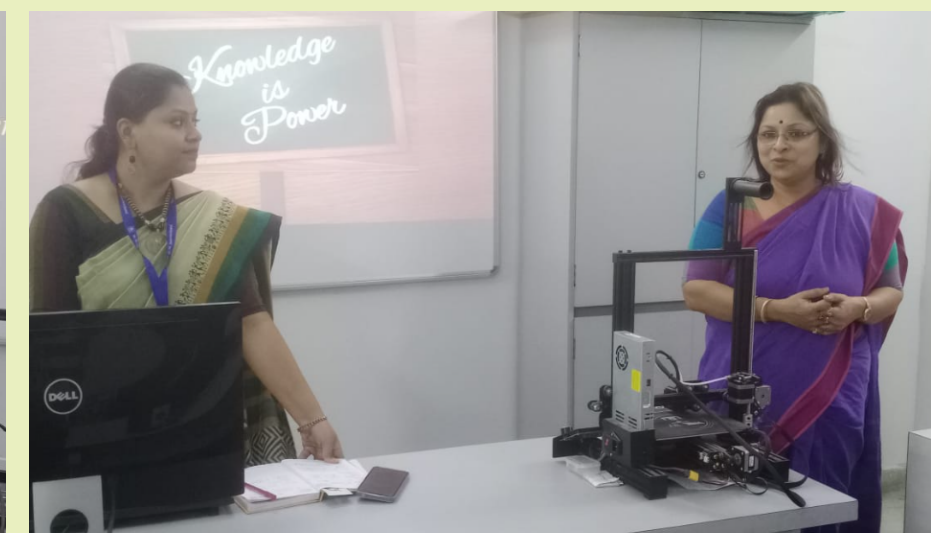
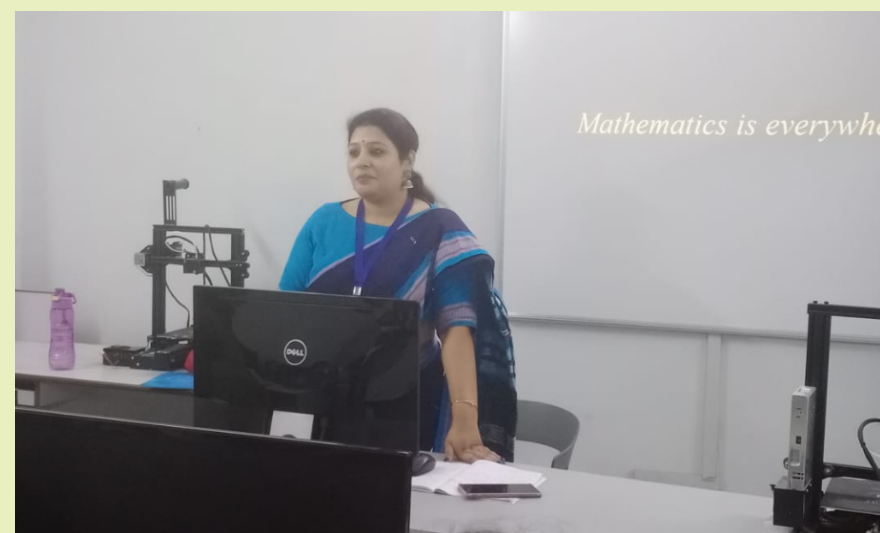
Digital Revolution of India

Difference between knowledge and qualification, Attitude of a motivational teacher, positive classroom environment, how to reduce stress and principals of effective learning were discussed in the workshop.



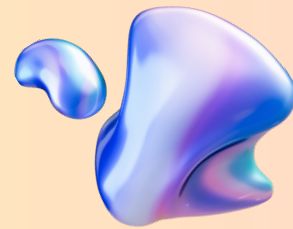
Morphosis in Education Facilitator: Debolina Chakraborty

CBSE Circular 07-2023 Storytelling Competition

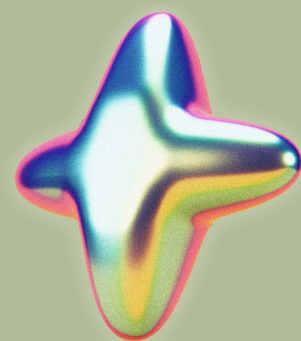

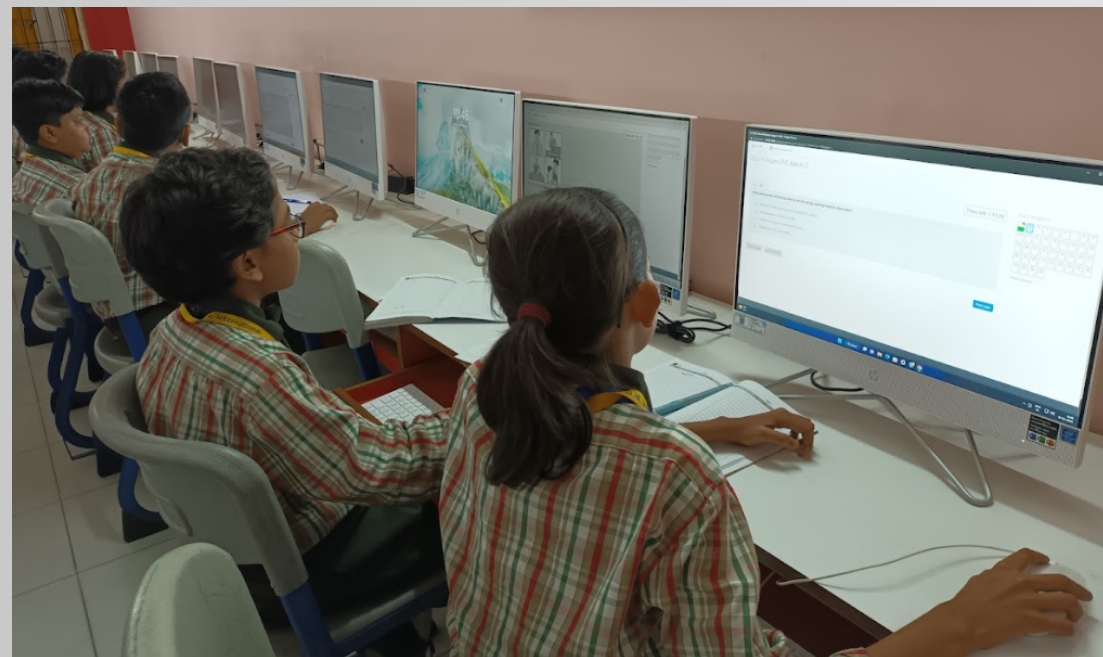


SAFAL Pilot Examination 2023 Demo

BDM International and Buturlinovskaya Secondary School collaborate for G20



The Group of Twenty (G20) is a premier forum for international economic co-operation that represents 60% of world's population and 75% of world trade. India, member of the G20, took the presidency from Indonesia, on December 1, 2022, and will hold the post for year. The G20 logo draws inspiration from the vibrant colours of India's national flag.

The theme of India's presidency 'Vasudhaiva kutumbakam' or 'One Earth, One Family, One Future'. The go and the theme together represents an unique Indian approach to G20 presidency, of living in harmony with the surrounding ecosystem. In regard to this, the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) will host the research and Innovation Initiative gathering (RIIG) meetings in Dui on scientific challenges and opportunities for a sustainable blue economy'.

CBSE has Sahodaya School Complexes (SSCs) which is a group of neighbourhood schools who have voluntarily come together to share and conduct different inter-school activities in the cities in which G20 meetings are to be convened. In order to enable students to gain insights on how G20 countries are playing a crucial role, several cities of India have been named to the G20 member countries. In regard to this, Kolkata, West Bengal, has been named to Russia. BDM International being a part of SSCs, in collaboration with a Russian School, Buturlinovskaya Secondary School, has taken the initiative to educate students on sustainable use and management of the ocean and its resources.

Keeping this in mind, our school structured 'Five projects' on the theme 'Blue sustainability'.

Poster and Placard making: Students from both the schools took interest in designing various posters and placards depicting 'Hear their cry: don't let die. Save the whales', 'Keep the ocean 'Less boats, more fish', to name a few.

Song and poem recitation: Students sang a song themed 'For water'. The students from the school in Russia cited a poem to convey the significance of water in our daily lives.

Special Assembly: Students of class had conducted a special assembly school on the G20 Summit and Resilient Innovative Initiative Gathering (RIIG) speech was delivered to make the students aware of India-Russia collaboration and necessity of rational use of World Ocean resources.

Sea beach cleaning using EV3 Model: With the help of technology, our students engineered a model which uses the 'sweeping arm' of a robot to throw the trash off the sea, thereby making the area visually pleasing.

Beach cleaning campaign: The students had participated in an initiative of the Government of India, 75 day long campaign along the coastline of the country. The aim of the drive was to clean up the beaches and create awareness among people so that we do not pollute water bodies by throwing plastic waste debris into them. The students were to be a part of the campaign.

To all Indians, the G20 summit is an extremely substantial place as the presidency, along with marking the 75th anniversary of the diplomatic relations of India with Russia, also marks the beginning of a 25 year period beginning from the anniversary of India's independence. Keeping this in mind, various individual collaborative activities were taken at local level to make the students aware of taking over G20 presidency for time.

She initiated the workshop by urging all educators to work as an integrated community who care, share and learn for the advancement of young learners. From reiterating the role of a teacher in kindling the spark in children for learning at a very early age to discussing the role of hippocampus and amygdala, she pointed out the brain functioning which renders children in performing activities involving arts, holistic thinking, visual skills, nonverbal cues, to name a few. Explaining thoroughly the significance of a joyous, age appropriate and child centric learning pedagogy, she laid emphasis on the importance of a leaning methodology that must be adopted by teachers to avoid stress and unnecessary burden on the learners. Vats concluded by discussing the significance of the New Education Policy, 2020 which lays utmost stress on education during the early and formative years where play-based learning techniques are to be used to keep the young minds engaged. It was indeed an enriching and delightful session where the educators-facilitators were once again reminded of the importance of a holistic approach to promoting newer pedagogies while keeping in mind the wholesome growth of the tiny tots.
