STRUCTURE OF ASSESSMENT SCHEME

- **Four Assessments are conducted throughout the session :**
 - ❖ **Periodic test-1: 40 marks**
 - ❖ **Periodic Test-2/Half Yearly: 80 marks**
 - ❖ **Periodic Test-3 : 60 marks**
 - ❖ **Annual examination : 80 marks**

Promotion Criteria

Based on the entire year's performance and as per CBSE norms as applicable.

Internal Assessment (20) :

- The average of two best exams [**Periodic test-1, Periodic Test-2/Half Yearly , Periodic Test-3**] will be considered : [5 marks]
 - **PORTFOLIO** – The portfolio may take the form of a journal or notebook that would include students' artefacts selected along with their reflections . Projects including AIL. [5 marks]
 - **SUBJECT ENRICHMENT** - Lab work and Lab notebook submission/ Activity/Map/related activities and projects [5 marks]
 - **MULTIPLE ASSESSMENT** – Multiple and diverse assessment techniques to assess learners, i.e., observation, oral tests, individual or group work, class discussion, field-work, concept maps, graphic organizers, visual representation etc. [5 marks]
 - The parameters which will decide the Internal Marks are – **Timely submission , neatness and upkeep of exercise books , quality and completion of work, involvement in the academic activities.**

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS



- **Students must come to school in proper school uniform.**

- **Attendance: It is compulsory for all students to maintain regular attendance during the course of academic session. 75% attendance is mandatory to enable them to appear for the final assessment.**
- **No student will be allowed to attend the class without a leave application if he/she has been absent the previous day. In case of absence on medical ground, the student should resume school with a fitness certificate.**
- **Parent's/Guardian's declaration : All parents are requested to go through the details given in the almanac carefully and sign the declaration given on page 58 of the school almanac.**

Mental health is our emotional, psychological, and social, well-being. It is how we think, feel, and act.

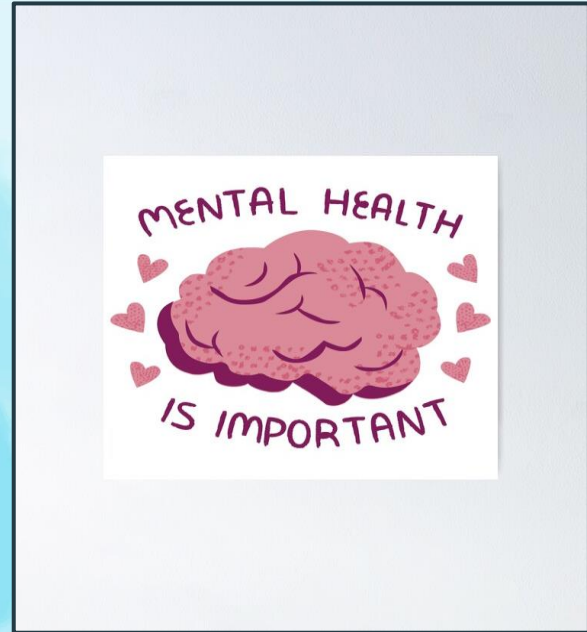
It helps determine how we handle stress, relate to others, and make healthy choices.

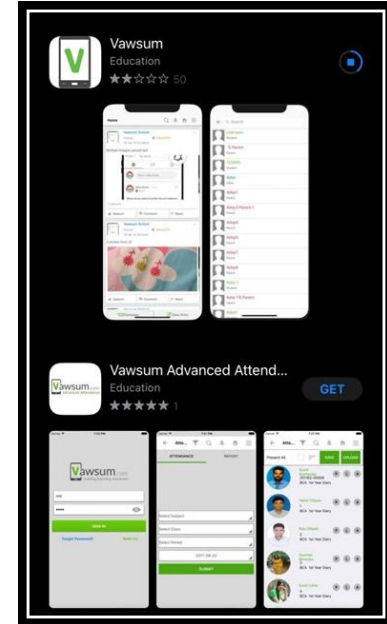
